Dear New Jersey Summer Flounder Permit Holder:
New Jersey Summer Flounder Dealer:

As of September 29, 2008 the Division of Fish and Wildlife has determined that approximately 274,465 pounds of summer flounder have been landed since the September/October directed season opened on September 7, 2008. Based upon this information and pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:25-18.12(i), the New Jersey directed summer flounder fishery will be closed as of 8:00 PM Saturday, October 4, 2008.

Effective 8:01 PM, October 4, 2008 no vessel shall land or possess nor shall any dealer accept any summer flounder in excess of the by-catch trip limit of 100 pounds through November 1, 2008 or until such time as the seasonal by-catch is projected to be taken. By-catch landings may not exceed ten percent, by weight, of all species landed and sold.

The directed summer flounder fishery will re-open on November 2, 2008 with a 1000 pound trip limit and a maximum of four landings per week or 3,000 pounds per trip with a maximum of one landing per week. If you have any questions, please contact the Bureau of Marine Fisheries at 609-748-2020.
