**About the Workshop:** Participants will meet up on May 5 at 6:30 p.m. on GoToMeeting for an interactive presentation to get introduced to the sport of surf fishing. This virtual portion will cover how to read the beach, equipment, live and artificial baits, species to target as well as regulations. You must attend the virtual meeting in order to participate in the in-person fishing day.

The in-person portion of the workshop will be held at **Island Beach State Park in Seaside Park, NJ** on Saturday, May 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. to try your hand at fishing the surf. All bait, tackle and equipment will be provided.
