Join the NJ Division of Fish and Wildlife's R3 Program in partnership with Game Creek Hunting Farms and the South Jersey Pheasants Forever Chapter for an introduction to upland hunting opportunities. This workshop is designed to provide participants 18 years of age or older an informative and welcoming environment in which to learn tips and techniques when upland game hunting.

Workshop Overview:

This workshop is for beginner female hunters who have yet to upland hunt. Participants will learn about upland hunting, regulations, equipment, techniques, and where to access upland hunting opportunities beyond this workshop. Included is a mentored pheasant hunt that will be followed by harvest processing techniques.

Workshop Fee:

This workshop is being offered **FREE** of charge!

Facilities:

The Game Creek Hunting Farms is located in Woodstown, New Jersey. The game farm was established to provide a quality hunting experience in a private and natural environment, while providing personal service that is friendly and professional. Participants will meet at the Club house where seating, restrooms, light snacks, and coffee will be available. After registration, participants will have the opportunity to shoot clays out of the wobble trap gazebo to become familiar with their firearm. Participants will travel by foot or their personal vehicle to assigned hunting fields.

Applications are selected based on current/previous outdoor recreation, experience, and locality of the semi-wild preserve. You will receive **e-mail** confirmation by October 29, 2021, if you are selected to participate, as well as what to bring to the workshop.

Requirements:

Participants must be at least 18 years of age and are required to possess a valid 2021 Firearm Hunting License or Apprentice Firearm Hunting License. All participants must provide their own hunting equipment; **All** ammunition will be provided, firearms can be provided upon request. All Division of Fish and Wildlife programs strictly adhere to current New Jersey Covid-19 safety protocols.
